A female Electro/Hip-Hop star has signed up as an official patron for the government backed **Every Child a Chance Trust** programmes.

Mz Bratt is a critically acclaimed new MC is signed to **All Around The World** (Universal Music) and label mates include **N-Dubz** who recently topped the UK charts with **Tinchy Stryder**.

17 year old **Mz Bratt** hopes to be a positive young role model for the charity that kids can look up and relate to.

Every Child a Chance Trust is a unique charity which has pioneered two ground breaking programs.

- 1) **Every Child A Reader:** which helps socially disadvantaged children to overcome literacy difficulties. The initiative funds highly-skilled Reading Recovery teachers in primary schools, to provide intensive help to children most in need.

Thanks to the charity, over three quarters of children (including those at the very lowest achieving schools where it is hardest to raise standards) reached average literacy levels for their age after an average of 40 hours of daily 1-1 teaching.

- 2) **Every Child Counts** helps socially disadvantaged children struggling with basic number skills. The initiative funds highly-skilled numeracy teachers in schools serving areas of high social deprivation. In the pilot study, children made an average of 15 months progress over just a 3 month period.

Mz Bratt is excited to be on board and is looking forward to doing whatever she can to help and support the cause. Her positive lyrics and involvement with the charity marks a steep turn away from the crime culture usually associated with and glamorized in the urban music scene.

Mz Bratt's single *Who Do You Think You Are?* Is out July 27th.
